WHAT WILL I STUDY?

LEVEL 1

Working safely and effectively during light vehicle maintenance and repair; foundation skills for light vehicle maintenance and repair; light vehicle construction and routine maintenance; operating principles of light vehicle tyres, brakes, steering and suspension systems; operating principles of light vehicle engines; operating principles and maintenance of light vehicle transmission systems; and maintenance of light vehicle electrical and electronic systems.

LEVEL 2

Practical work on light vehicles and computer-based learning activities. Two units cover topics such as automotive vehicle workshop practices; workshop health and safety; workshop control and customer care; employment law; organisation and representation structures; and impact of public law and policies on operations. The second unit is the diagnosis of complex faults and repair. You will also be encouraged to develop your skills in maths, English and IT.

LEVEL 3

Provides the necessary skills in motor vehicle repair for progression to employment through the apprenticeship scheme. You will gain experience in all aspects of motor vehicle repair. You will also continue to develop your skills in maths, English and ICT.

Entry to **Level 3** is dependant on completion of Level 2 course.

COURSE LENGTH

All courses are full-time for one academic year.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

At **Levels 1 and 2** assessment is ongoing throughout the course and there are also end of module online tests for each unit.

At **Level 3** there is one written exam and one practical exam.

WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?

You may progress from **Level 1** to **Level 3**.
