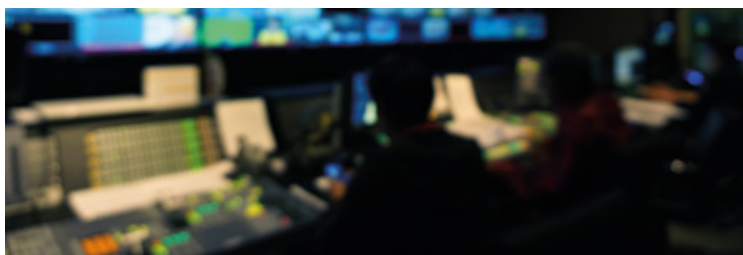

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

These courses are designed to provide you with the very best skills to enter a fast-moving, creative and expanding industry. Creative digital media skills can lead to a range of diverse careers. Employers are looking for those who have good technical skills to develop moving image, audio, multimedia and radio content.

You will develop your ideas from the planning and preproduction stages through to post-production and audience feedback. You will learn to research and plan a production, taking into account the logistics and technologies required. You will be taught to combine a vital understanding of your target audience with the scriptwriting and production management skills the industry requires to operate efficiently. This will include the production techniques for audio and video taught alongside the theory, to provide experience in television and radio industries.

COURSE LENGTH

Level 2 course is full-time for one academic year.
Level 3 courses are full-time for two academic years.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Continuously through coursework, with group and individual assignments. Courses include exams and external units.

Assignments range from adverts to the creation of television drama and music videos. In radio you will create varied audio pieces.
