Wigan & Leigh College is committed to supporting you to understand and value careers education and planning. We will support you to develop your skills and knowledge to make informed decisions and follow your career pathway to future success.

### TRANSITION TO COLLEGE

We provide support in making your choices around where to study after school and offer all 16-18 year olds an Information, Advice and Guidance interview with a knowledgeable and supportive Admissions interviewer. They will discuss your career aspirations, predicted grades and give you advice on courses and apprenticeships. They will tell you more about college life and answer any questions you may have at this stage. We have a wide range of starting points as well as pathways such as A Levels, Technical and Vocational qualifications (such as T Levels and BTECS) and Apprenticeships.

We also offer lots of opportunities for you to discover more about the college, so you can make sure it is the right place for you. This includes open evenings, course information and virtual tours on our website, sampling days for those in year 10, a New Student Welcome day before you start at college and a Year 11 portal to help ensure you are ready for the next step to college.

### YOUR CAREER PASSPORT

You will have the opportunity to capture all of the careers activity you undertake whilst at college in one place, to help you with planning and decision making. Careers education is not about one single experience or opportunity but is about a range of experiences, research and learning within and beyond your course.

### **ONE-TO-ONE CAREERS GUIDANCE**

The purpose of a one-to-one careers guidance session with a qualified careers adviser is to identify any barriers to your progression and achievement. It is also to look for gaps in your knowledge that we can support you and to help you see your true potential to achieve, whilst understanding and valuing lifelong learning and the ability to make fact based decisions throughout your future. We offer these to all of our students during their time at college. We have a programme of targeted support that we believe aligns with key decision making points in your time with us. Our FAB Futures centres are open for you to make an appointment with an adviser when you feel it would benefit you.

### **FAB FUTURES**

We are the team you can turn to in college for all things course, careers and work experience related. We have staff based at all campuses to help you work out what you need to keep moving forward with your aspirations.

We have been Matrix accredited for over 20 years and continue to strive to go above the expectations of this quality standard for Information, Advice and Guidance.

The college has also achieved the Gatsby Benchmarks for Good Careers Guidance and is playing a key role in developing standards beyond the benchmarks.
