WHAT WILL I STUDY?

You will gain an insight into the childcare and early years sector, exploring a range of topics, including: practical care skills; personal and social development; legislation framework and professional practice; play; safeguarding; and health and safety. Your studies will prepare you to work with children from birth to five years, with knowledge of children up to seven years.

T Level students will benefit from our partnership with Edge Hill University with visits to campus, sessions delivered by university academics and meetings with current trainee teachers. You will also receive support from them with UCAS applications and a guaranteed interview if you choose to apply for a course there.

COURSE LENGTH

Levels 1 and 2 are full-time for one academic year. **Level 3** are full-time for two academic years.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

Through continual assessment using practical observations, written assignments and synoptic assessments similar to exams.

WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?

From **Levels 1 and 2** you may progress to a **Level 3** full-time programme, or an apprenticeship.

Those studying **Level 3** may progress to employment in a childcare setting, a related field or to the Foundation Degree Children, Young People and their Services at the University Centre Wigan & Leigh College.
