WHAT WILL I STUDY?

You will study drawing, painting, sculpture, illustration, textiles and print making. You can choose from a wide range of subjects including graphics, photography or digital and imaging design. Each specialism has dedicated production-based studios and university standard facilities.

You will develop your skills, especially in drawing and visual communication, to improve your knowledge of the arts, while studying its history and concepts. We tailor the course around your interests, abilities and aspirations to prepare you for higher level study or employment in your specialist pathway.

COURSE LENGTH

Level 1 course is full-time for one academic year.

Level 2 course is full-time for one academic year.

Level 3 courses are full-time for two academic years apart from Foundation Diploma (Pre-degree) which is one year.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

You will be assessed as you progress, through live projects set by clients and coursework.

You are also encouraged to evaluate your own progress during regular tutorials and one-to-one discussions with your tutors.

WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?

Those who have completed **Levels 1 and 2** may progress to **Level 3**. When you have completed **Level 3** or **Level 3 Foundation Diploma** you may study a university level course in a related subject area.

You may go directly into employment in an arts setting. Many of our students have progressed to elite universities and achieve outstanding grades.
