## WHAT WILL I STUDY?

#### **LEVEL 2 MUSIC**

You will develop a range of skills, including rehearsal techniques for musicians and music recording production. You will be involved in planning, creating and performing. Most of the work is practical, but some aspects of assignments are written and you will need to reflect on your performance.

#### LEVEL 3 AUDIO & MUSIC PRODUCTION

Also delivered in module form: recording and producing bands and artists; creating music and sound for film, game and TV; soundtracks; producing electronic music; acoustics and synthesis; and live sound engineering. You will also learn about the music industry and how to set up your own business, or work as a freelancer.

#### LEVEL 3 MUSIC PRACTICE

Delivered in module form to include: practical study of different styles and genres of popular music; and live music events. Other areas include music technology; recording; singing; composition and arranging. Some modules, such as the sound and music industry, help you to understand how the music business works and explore potential career opportunities.

All music (performance) students will attend an audition at the college prior to enrolment.

### **HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?**

You will be continually assessed through practical work, live performance, written assignments and a major project.

## **WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?**

You may progress from Level 2 to Level 3.
