CAREER PROSPECTS

The starting salary for police constables is \pounds 21,402, rising to \pounds 41,130 at the top of the scale - achievable after about seven years.

The starting salary for a trainee firefighter is \pounds 24,191. When fully trained, this rises to \pounds 32,244. Higher rates apply for overtime.

Royal Naval Officers may earn £31,000 a year.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

LEVEL 1

The programme includes: health and fitness for the public services; dealing with incidents; map reading and navigation; assisting the public; teamwork and communication.

LEVEL 2

Units include: role and work of the public services; skills for working in the public services; crime and its effects; employability skills; fitness and outdoor activities. You will take part in a range of work related activities. You may choose to complete the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award.

LEVEL 3

The course includes: citizenship and diversity; behaviour and discipline in the uniform protective services; physical preparation; teamwork leadership and communication; custodial care; managing security and the law. You will also take part in a range of voluntary and work related activities to enhance employability skills. You may also choose to complete the Duke of Edinburgh Silver Award.

COURSE LENGTH

Level 1 and 2 courses are full-time for one academic year and the Level 3 course is full-time for two academic years.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

You will be assessed through a mix of practical and written assignments, observations, written tests and formal external examinations.

There are no exams at Level 1.

WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?

You may progress from Level 1 through to Level 3.

On successful completion at **Level 3**, you may progress to university. Higher education courses include the HND Public Services at the University Centre Wigan & Leigh College as well as a wide range of degrees at other providers including: Criminology, Police Science and Public Services Management.
