WHAT WILL I STUDY?

You will carry out safe working practices in construction, use information, quantities and communicate with others, learn building methods and construction technology, prepare background surfaces and plaster materials, apply plaster materials to internal backgrounds and produce components from moulds

You will progress to learn how to apply plaster materials to external surfaces, fix dry lining and plasterboard products to interiors, form sand and cement screeds, produce plaster components, apply plaster materials to internal surfaces, position and secure fibrous plaster components and take a practical assessment.

COURSE LENGTH

Courses are full-time for one academic year.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

You will take a short test and have practical assessments. There is also an externally set theory test at the end of the **Level 2** course.

WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?

You may progress to apprenticeships, employment or self-employment. The college has strong links with employers who send more than 300 students on a day release basis to study construction trades.
