CAREER PROSPECTS

Highly experienced Cabin Crew can earn up to £28k a year on average. You could earn more with overtime and flight allowances. Some airlines offer free or discounted flights to cabin crew staff and their families.

Salaries in Event Management can range from £20k - £40k a year.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Cabin Crew students will study airline and aviation operations; airline health, safety and security; airline emergency procedures; cabin crew room duties; role of cabin crew (on board); preparation for employment as air cabin crew; beverage services; personal presentation skills; plus essential skills in maths and English.

Travel and Tourism students will study: customer service and interpersonal skills in travel and tourism; worldwide travel destinations; and transportation for travel and tourism. Further units of study could include visitor attractions; holiday representatives; promotional activities and travel planning.

At **Level 3** further units include: special interest tourism, airfares and ticketing; arranging business travel; cruises, conference and events; holiday park host; and ski chalet hosts.

You will also learn the generic skills demanded in every industry, to secure employment in any organisation.

COURSE LENGTH

The Level 2 courses are full-time for one academic year.

The Level 3 course is full-time for two academic years.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

The course is continually assessed using a range of methods including coursework, assignments, practical performance and written tests.

The **Level 3** course also includes an exam.

WHAT CAN I PROGRESS TO?

You may progress from **Level 2 to 3**.

On successful completion at **Level 3**, you may secure employment or go on to study at the University Centre Wigan & Leigh College on the HND International Travel and Tourism Management programme.

Alternatively you may choose from a wide range of degrees including: Event Management, Tourism Management and Leisure & Tourism at other higher education institutions.
